

In Person Puppet Making Workshop Waiver Form

Acknowledgment and Acceptance of Risk

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19 has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. While Creative Skills Society has taken the appropriate steps to mitigate the risk of COVID-19 being transmitted at any of its workshops, Creative Skills Society cannot guarantee or prevent your warden from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 as a result of attending a Puppet Making Workshop. It is not possible to prevent against the presence of the disease. Therefore, if your warden chooses to attend the Puppet Making Workshop your warden would be exposing himself/herself to and/or increasing his/her risk of contracting and/or spreading COVID-19.

Accordingly, I acknowledge that it is my personal and voluntary decision to allow my warden to attend this Puppet Making Workshop on 19th Dec. 2021. I acknowledge that I understand and freely assume any and all risks by of attending in person the Puppet Making Workshop of how my warden. I further acknowledge that my warden is not symptomatic for COVID-19, and to the extent that my warden has been tested for COVID-19, and he/she has not tested positive for the virus. Furthermore, my warden is not considered as high-risk person to contract and have complications from the COVID-19 disease. Moreover, if at any time my warden becomes symptomatic for COVID-19 I will immediately notify the Creative Skills Society to enable the other participants of the workshop in any contact-tracing that the local jurisdiction may require. I will ask my warden to discontinue in-person attendance to the Puppet Making Workshop for at least 14 days for a self-imposed quarantine. In order to attend the in-person Puppet Making Workshop, I will follow and comply with all directives that are given from time to time by the Creative Skills Society which may require including, but not limited to, wearing face coverings and maintaining social distancing from the other participants of at least the minimum distance required by local law. I further acknowledge that it is my responsibility to review and comply with any government, state, or local directives, advisories, warnings, or any other information regarding COVID-19 and which are directed to individuals, and based on those guidelines, I freely assume any and all risks which may accompany those guidelines and/or directives for my warden.

Waiver, Release, and Hold Harmless. In consideration for being permitted to attend in- person Puppet Making Workshop, I do hereby on behalf of my warden forever release and waive my right to bring suit against the any person of Creative Skills Society and its affiliates, together with all of their respective present and former officers, employees, other participants, agents, servants, representatives, parents, successors, and assigns in connection with exposure, infection and/or spread of COVID-19 related to the attendance of in person Puppet Making Workshop by my warden. I understand that this waiver means that I give up my right to bring any claims introducing claims for the personal injuries, death, disease or property losses, or any other loss, including but not limited to claims of negligence, and give up any claim I may have to seek damages, whether known or

unknown, foreseen or unforeseen on behalf of my warden. The Waiver, Release, and Hold Harmless shall be binding upon my survivors, heirs, successors, and assigns. I understand and agree that this Waiver, Release and Hold Harmless is a release of liability and I sign it on my own free will.

Choice of Law: I understand and agree that the law of the Republic of India will apply to this Acknowledgment and Acceptance of Risk.
